Policy For Limited Funds

Policy: In accordance with Section 134 (d)(4)(E) of the Workforce Investment Act of 1998 and Section 134 (c)(3)(#) of the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act of 2014, the Local Workforce Development Board (LWDB) determined adult employment and training funds are limited, priority for individualized career services and training services funded with Title I adult funds must be given to recipients of public assistance, veterans and other low-income individuals, who are basic skills deficient in the local area. Exceptions include candidates for the following LWDB adopted industry sectors:

- Health and Medical care to include Licensed Vocational Nursing and Registered Nursing;
- Manufacturing;
- Agribusiness, including Food Processing, Agricultural Technology and Biotechnology
- Supply chain Management and Logistics ;
- Renewable Energy
- Public Infrastructure
- Water Technology
